



# Electric Miscellaneous - Residential Permit Guidelines

## Electrical Contractor or Owner/Builder may apply for permit

- Trade application.
- Owner Builder Affidavit (if homeowner).
- NOC required if value is \$2500 or greater.

### Description:

- Description of work being done (i.e. wiring of boat lift, replace meter can, etc)

### Route to: OFFICE USE ONLY

- CSR to approve over the counter.

### Processing: OFFICE USE ONLY

- Type: Electric Misc
- Subtype: Residential

### Inspections:

- Notice of Commencement (NOC) 10
- Electric Final (040) 20
- Hook-up/SRV CHG (023) 20 \*\*if required

### Fees:

- Electric Misc w/o Plans \$ 80.00
- Surcharge YES/NO \***No Surcharge for Docks & Boat Lifts**

### Expiration:

- Six (6) months

### NOTES:

Any work that requires LCEC to come out and disconnect/reconnect the power should receive both the Electric Hook-up/SRVCHG (023) and the Electric Final (040). Examples include panel replacement, riser replacement, meter can replacements and houses labeled as grow houses.
