



YARD WASTE PREPARATION

- There is **NO** change to Yard Waste Collection. Yard Waste is prepared the same way you currently prepare for collection. You may use your existing garbage cans for yard waste collection.

The following items are picked up regularly: • Grass Clippings • Tree Limbs • Fallen Fruit • Palm Fronds • Leaves Branches

- Place leaves, grass, fruit, twigs, etc. in plastic can, or in plastic garbage bags, or special paper bags designed to hold leaves.
 - Can size should be 40 gallons or less with weatherproof lid and handles on each side.
 - Weight of can should not exceed 50 lbs.
 - Tie tree limbs and branches in bundles that are no longer than 6 feet in length, limbs greater than 4 inches in diameter and bundles weighing no more than 50 lbs.
 - Palm fronds do not need to be bundled, but stacked neatly. There is no limitation to the size of palm fronds.
- There is a charge for collection of land clearing debris. Call Waste Pro (239) 945-0800 for information.

<p>Items Not Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wet, waxed or soiled paper • Used paper towels and plates • Carbon paper 	<p>Items Not Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wet or soiled cardboard 	<p>Items Not Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Light bulbs • Window glass, drinking glasses or mirrors 	<p>Items not Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cans used for chemicals or paints • Aerosol spray cans • Appliances, power tools or batteries 	<p>Items Not Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Containers used for chemicals or automotive products (oil, antifreeze, etc.) • Rubber products • Styrofoam cups and packing material • Photographic film • Plastic bags • Polyvinyl sheeting • Heat shrink wrapping
