MEMORANDUM TO ALL PARENTS**

**** PARENTS PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING****

First and foremost, thank you to all participants (players, parents and all other spectators) for participating in the CCPR Youth Basketball league. We would like to let everyone involved with the league know that this is a recreation league and is not meant to be competitive (**WINNING & LOSING IS NOT IMPORTANT**). Although each game has a winning and losing team, the program was established for the participants to 1) **HAVE FUN!** 2) Learn the basic fundamentals of the game. As adults, we need to keep in mind that this is a **YOUTH** program and is intended to keep the welfare of the participants free of any adult ambition or personal glory.

Listed below are a few Rules and Guidelines that we feel are very important.

MANDATORY PRACTICE & GAME POLICY:

** Each player is required to play two (2) full quarters, unless he/she is being disciplined.*

1. All players are expected to be at every practice and game unless they have an **acceptable excuse**. (*Family, school, or church function, illness, family emergency, & vacation are examples of acceptable excuses*)
2. If a player cannot make a practice or game, they are expected to let the coach know ahead of time so that he/she can make the necessary adjustments.
3. All players are expected to be on time for all YBL functions. If a player shows up after the first quarter is finished, he/she will forfeit their guaranteed (2) two quarters, and will only play (1) one.
4. **If a player is absent from a practice or game and does not let the coach know in advance with an acceptable excuse, the player is subject to disciplinary action for the next attended game(s).**
5. All players must wear the uniform provided by the City of Cape Coral, unless preapproved by the league supervisor. If a player is not wearing their uniform (jersey and **BLACK** basketball shorts) he/she may be disciplined for their game. – **STRICTLY ENFORCED**
