## **Green Industry Best Management Practice (GI-BMP) North Fort Myers Recreation Center**

The GI-BMP class is required if you apply fertilizer or maintain landscapes as a primary business in Lee County. This six hour class includes pre and post-tests. Both exams are exactly alike. Successful completion of the exam will entitle you to an occupational certification and county issued stickers for your work vehicles. Your certificate of completion will be recognized by other counties and municipalities in the state of Florida. There is no expiration date on this certification.
