

Seahawk Park Reopening Safety Plan

- Flying shall commence no sooner than April 23, 2020;
- Access to Seahawk Park will be limited to members of the R/Seahawk Flying Club and guests only (*No spectators*); Signage will be posted at the field entrance; Spectator control will be done by City officials only;
- Park hours will be limited to 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (No night flying);
- R/Seahawk membership badges must be worn in plain sight;
- Members who don't feel well should not go to the field;
- Anyone onsite must maintain strict social distancing at all times;
- All plastic chairs will be placed in storage, and the benches in the main pavilion will be cordoned off; People must bring their own chairs and take them home each day;
- The foot-operated, hand wash station will be available for use;
- There will be a posted advisory warning at the battery charging station, and work tables will be available so people can avoid contact with public surfaces; These surfaces will be disinfected periodically;
- When people are waiting for a flight station, flyers must exit their aircraft via the side entrances; No walking is permitted near or behind flyers;
- A maximum of six people are permitted in the vicinity of each pavilion at any time

We believe that this safety plan will minimize any potential exposure of R/Seahawk members and the public to the virus. Everyone's full compliance to this plan is greatly appreciated.
