

Re-Opening

Guidelines for Skate Park

Phase 2

Cleaning and other Precautions:

- Hand Sanitizer will be available for customers and employees.
- Staff will be encouraged in washing hands often per the CDC and FDA.
- Staff and customers will have their temperature tested upon arrival.
- Staff will have masks and gloves provided to them.
- Staff will increase the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high-touch surfaces, such as counter tops and door handles.

Attendance:

- 50% capacity for the outdoor skate deck
- 25% capacity for all indoor space

Food Handling Practices:

- Employees will follow FDA recommendations during COVID-19 Pandemic
- The skate park will have a designated pick up counter. This will help limit physical contact when handing over food and beverages.
- An increase of routine cleaning and sanitation of coolers will be put in place.
- Utensils, dishware, and food preparation surfaces will be cleaned after every use.

Hours of Operation:

- **Camp Hours:**
7am-3pm | Monday-Friday
- **Skate Park Hours:**
3-9pm | Monday-Friday
12-9pm| Saturday
12-7pm| Sunday
- The Skate Park stay afterwards for 30 minutes for cleaning purposes. Staff will stay after to clean all areas and surfaces thoroughly.

Social Distancing:

- To control the skate park's limited space, re-entry will not be allowed during phase 2.
- Physical distancing and moderate social distancing will be practiced per the "Opening Up America Again" plan and CDC guidelines. The Skate Camp's ratio will be limited to 9 children per counselor.

Phase 3

Cleaning and other Precautions:

- Hand Sanitizer will be available for use for customers and employees.
- Staff will be encouraged in washing hands often per the CDC and FDA.
- Staff will have masks and gloves provided to them.
- Staff will continue the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high-touch surfaces, such as counter tops and door handles.

Attendance:

- 75% capacity for the outdoor skate deck
- 50% capacity for all indoor space

Food Handling Practices:

- Employees will follow FDA recommendations during COVID-19 Pandemic (PDF Attached).
- The skate park will continue to have a designated pick up counter. This will help limit physical contact when handing over food and beverages.
- Routine cleaning and sanitation of coolers will be scheduled as normal.
- Utensils, dishware, and food preparation surfaces will be cleaned after every use.

Hours of Operation:

- **Camp Hours:**
7am-3pm | Monday-Friday
- **Skate Park Hours:**
12-9pm | Monday-Saturday
12-6pm | Sunday
- The Skate Park stay afterwards for 30 minutes for cleaning purposes. Staff will stay after to clean all areas and surfaces thoroughly.

Social Distancing:

- Re-entry will be allowed again within reason. Attendees must have their daily admission wristband on upon re-entry.
- Physical distancing will continue to be practiced per the “Opening Up America Again” plan and CDC guidelines.
- The Skate Camp’s ratio will return to its intended 13 children per counselor ratio.
