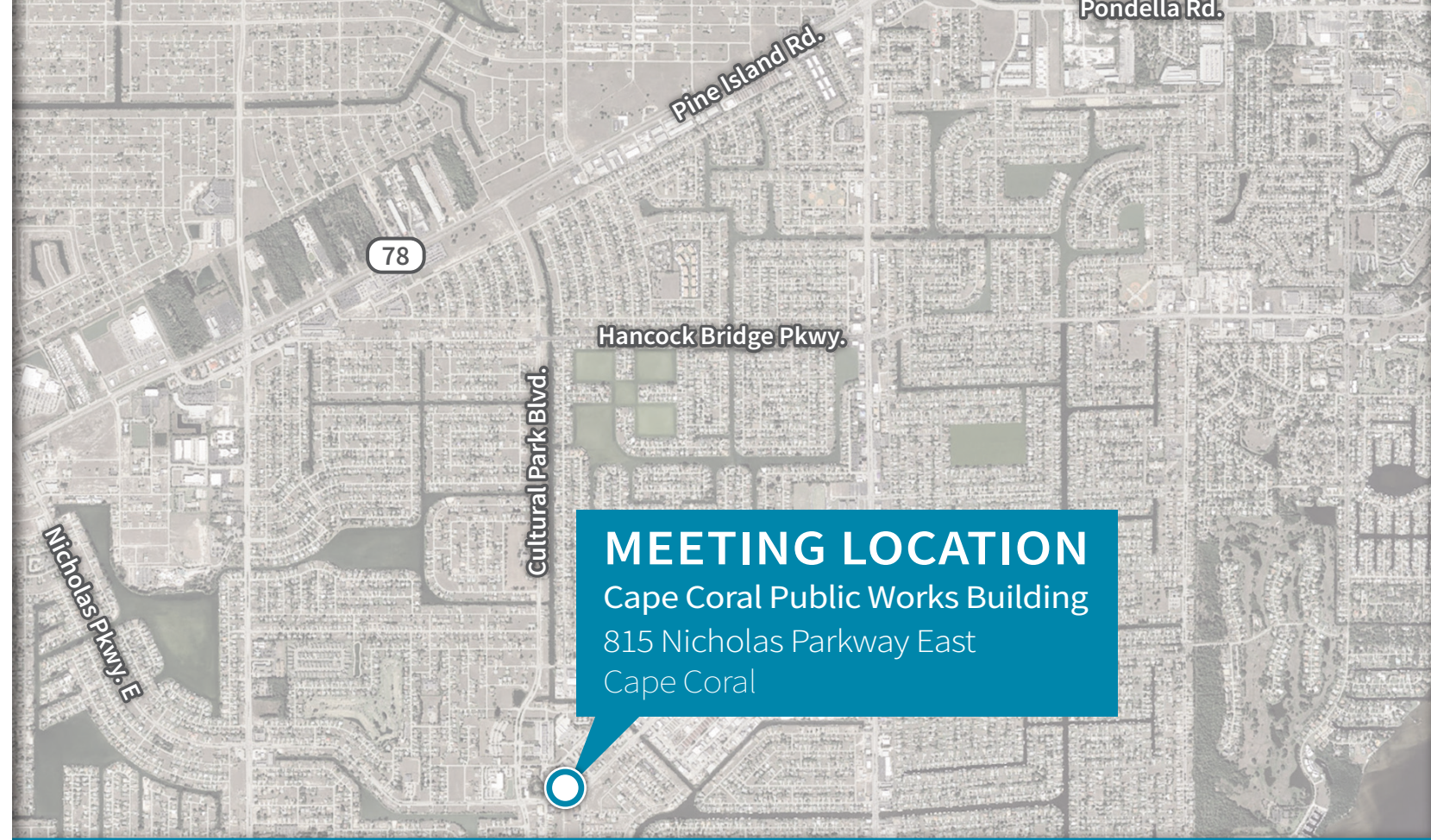
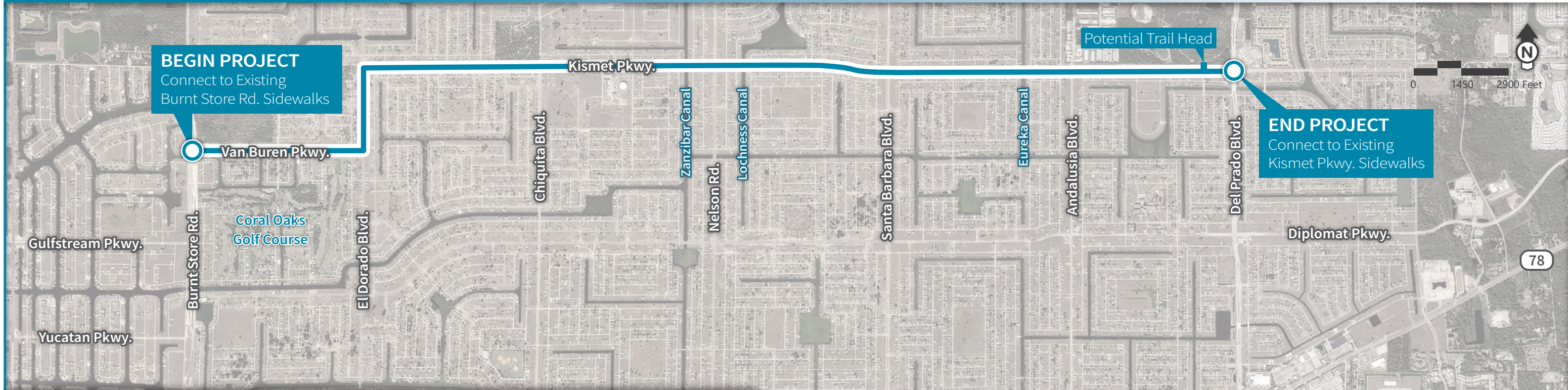

PROJECT INFORMATION

On behalf of the City of Cape Coral, you are invited to a public meeting regarding plans for the City's Florida Shared-Use Non-Motorized (SUN) trail, a bicycle and pedestrian multi-use trail, along the north side of Van Buren Parkway from Burnt Store Road to El Dorado Boulevard, along the east side of El Dorado Boulevard from Van Buren Parkway to Kismet Parkway, and along the north side of Kismet Parkway from El Dorado Boulevard to Del Prado Boulevard. The total project length is approximately 6.5 miles. The project involves construction of a new 12-foot wide multi-use trail and three new pedestrian bridges over the Zanzibar, Loch Ness, and Eureka Canals. This trail is part of the Florida Greenways and Trail network and is being funded for design and construction as part of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Florida Shared-Use Non-Motorized (SUN) Trail program. The purpose of this public meeting is to receive public input from the local community.
